Dear Parents & Carers,

The 2014 annual Athletics Carnival is being held in Week 9 of this term.

- When: **Thursday 26th June 2014 (Week 9)**.
- Where: Mingara Athletics Centre.
- Cost: **\$11.00 per student** payable to your child's class teacher by **Monday 23rd June (Week 9)**.
- Departure times: Primary 3-6 (& Year 2's turning 8) ⇒ 9:15 am
Infants K-2 ⇒ 10:00 am



Cost to each student is **\$11.00** which covers bus travel to and from the carnival, and entry to Mingara Athletics Centre. Unfortunately we are unable to split this cost and each student is to pay the full amount if attending the carnival. It is expected that all children will attend the carnival and will travel by bus. Students will return to school by 2:45pm. Any parents transporting their own children home from Mingara will need to have their name marked off by your child's class teacher at the gate when leaving at the end of the day. There is no entry fee for spectators.

Students should wear their sports uniform on the day and may wear a shirt in their house colour. Students should bring something to sit on (eg: a blanket, towel or mat), a hat, sunscreen, plenty of water to drink and adequate food for the day. It does get cold and windy at Mingara so please ensure your child has warm clothing. In all events, students are required to wear appropriate shoes (7mm tartan/synthetic track spikes are allowed for the track events ONLY). **This year the P&C will be operating a BBQ selling yummy food for lunch.** Students will be able to purchase lunch from the BBQ only. Further information about what will be available and cost will be published in upcoming newsletters. Mingara canteen facilities will be available to parents only – **no student is to be in the canteen area at any time**. All students are to remain in their house areas throughout the day unless competing in an event. If it is raining on the day of the carnival, an announcement as to whether it is still on will be made on 2GO and SeaFM radio stations by 8am.

As always we require your generous support in helping out with official duties on the day. These may include helping with long jump, timekeeping, judging and infants novelty events. Any help is greatly appreciated. Please indicate on the slip above if you are available.

The theme for our Athletics Carnival is participation and fun. All competitors receive points for their house just for having a go. We invite all parents and family members to come and enjoy this great day with us and cheer on our aspiring athletes. Good luck to everyone!
