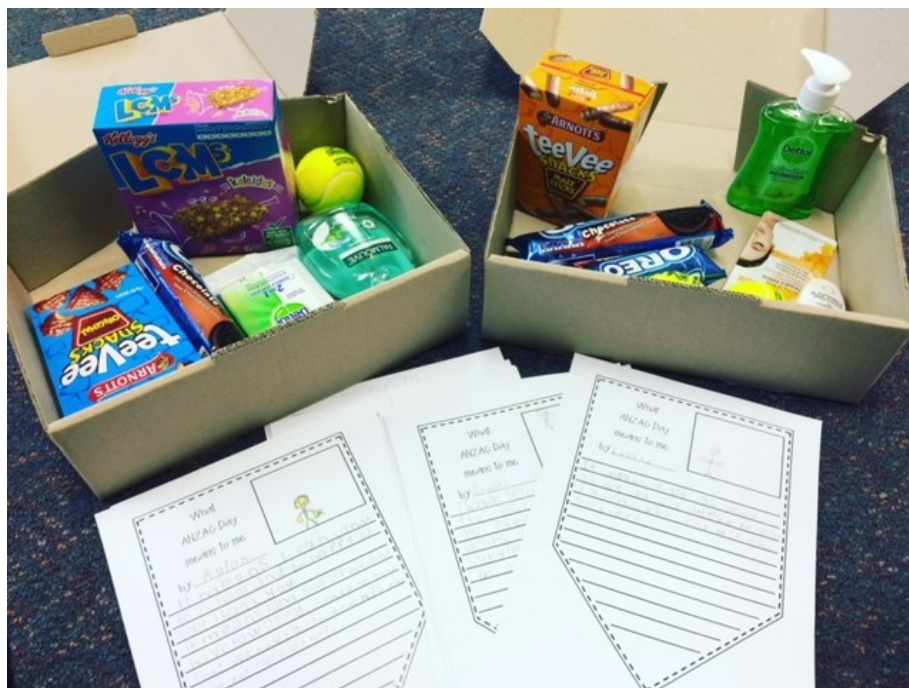
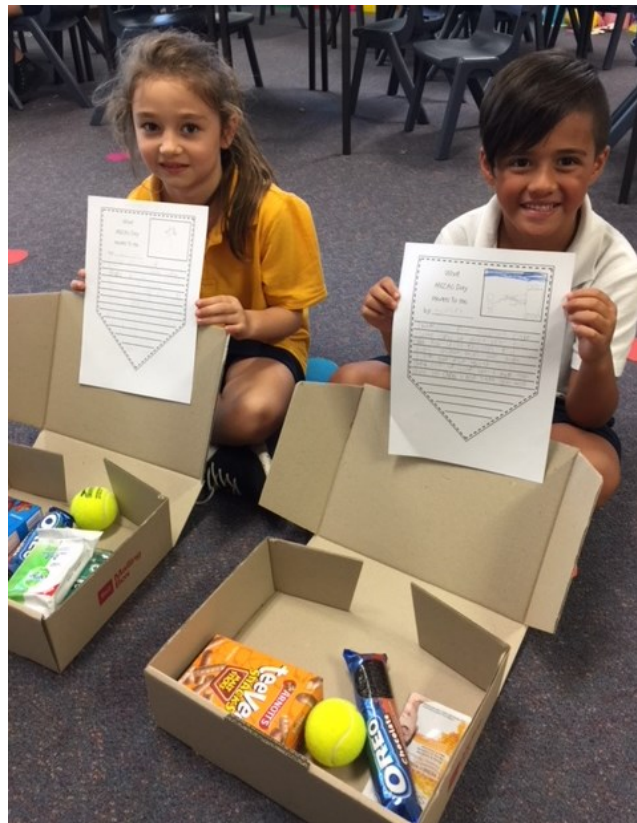

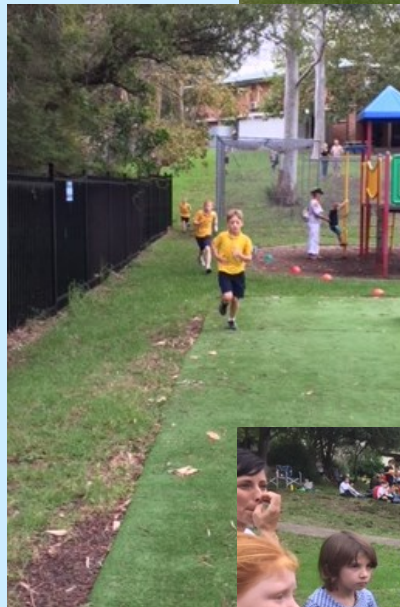
2/3G packaged some treats for our Defence Force currently serving. Each student chose an item to send, and wrote about what ANZAC Day means to them.

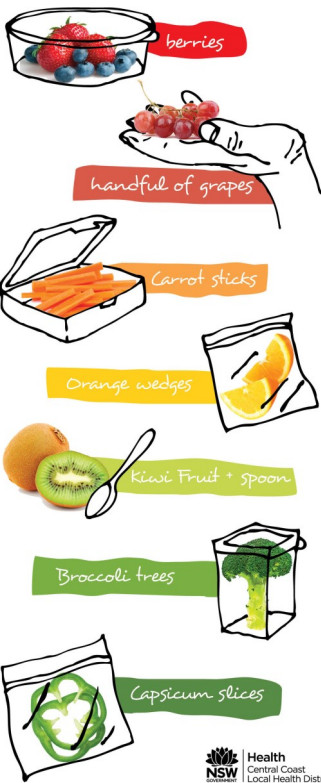
