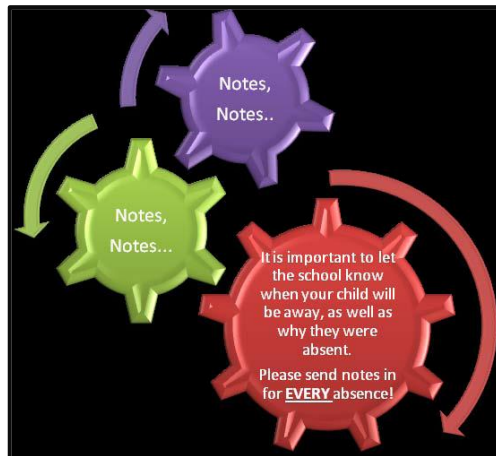


3/4S

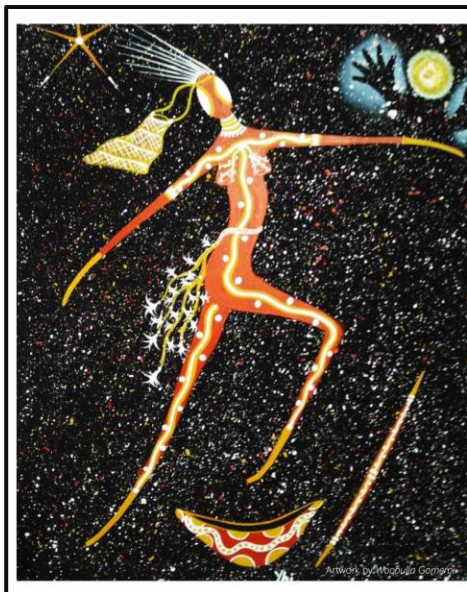
