



The **A stream class** for year 7 in 2021 will cater for high performing academic students who will have the opportunity to learn with peers who demonstrate a love of learning, a high level of motivation as well as strong literacy and numeracy skills. Teaching and learning will specifically cater for students with independent learning skills. Different learning styles will be catered for in a challenging environment and access to web- based applications will also be implemented.

Year 6 students have the opportunity to nominate for inclusion in the A stream class at EHS along with Teacher and parent recommendations. Applications will be considered by a panel of staff from EHS.

Students interested to apply for this class will be invited to sit a test focusing on literacy, numeracy, and creative problem solving **at your Primary School.** No preparation for the test is required and is non-calculator based for the numeracy components.

Please note, nomination for the A Stream class does not mean acceptance into the class.

### **Selection Criteria**

- Strong academic performance across a range of subjects;
- Good literacy and numeracy skills; minimum band 7 in year 5 NAPLAN reading, writing and numeracy
- Sound research skills, including library and Internet skills;
- High level of self-motivation;
- Positive attitudes to school and learning, including homework;
- Ability to work in a team in learning situations; and
- Positive and intelligent behaviour's which enhance learning.

All class placements are provisional, dependent on the student performance. EHS reserves the right to change a student's placement where evidence exists that the needs of all students may better be served by doing so. The class size will initially be limited to 27-28, to provide the flexibility to accommodate new students to the area at the beginning of 2021. Some changes may occur at the beginning of the year to adjust all classes when final numbers are known.

#### For students to be eligible they need to:

- 1. Complete the Application attached in this letter which includes a student and parent reflection statement.
- 2. A teacher will complete a Teacher Recommendation document also attached.
- 3. An attach copy of Year 5 NAPLAN results
- 4. Return by the dates indicated on the A stream application form to your Primary School Friday 22nd May Week 4 Term 2, 2020
