## REWARDS:

### Chesters

Throughout the School day, students earn Chesters and store them in their classroom.

### PBL Shop

Students can spend their Chesters at our weekly PBL Shop during Lunch 1 playtime each Friday.

### Merit Awards

Students can collect their Merit Awards and bring in 3 to receive a Principal's Award (in the year).

### Principal's Award

Students can collect 5 Principal's Awards over their schooling and bring them in to receive an Honours Certificate.

### Chester Challenge Card

Students bring home their card each Friday to be returned Monday. They must reach a total score listed on their card in order to participate in the end of term reward day.

### Chester Badge

Students must have a total score of 1000 on multiple Chester Challenge Cards across multiple years, to achieve the Chester Badge.

### Positive Behaviour for Learning

PBL is a consistent, school-wide system of support that helps define, teach and support appropriate student behaviours, creating a positive school environment.

## Positive Rewards for Good Behaviour
